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Deuteronomy 4.1-10 NIV onscreen

Look at verse 9

⁹Only **be careful**, and **watch yourselves** closely so that you **do not forget** the things your eyes have seen **or let them fade** from your heart as long as you live. Teach them to your children and to their children after them. Deuteronomy 4:9 (NIV)

When we forget what God has done.

- We forget Who He is.
- We forget who's we are.

As Israel Forgot the Lord

- They broke the Ten Commandments
- They worshipped Idols
- They married pagans
- They raised children who did worse

God disciplined them in the judges, allowing enemies to oppress them they cried out, sent deliverer.

God sent the Law, Installed a priesthood, sent the prophets.

=It can be costly when we forget: (Ill-basement, fridge)

Then He sent His Son..

¹In the past God spoke to our ancestors through the prophets at many times and in various ways,

²but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom also he made the universe. Hebrews 1.1-2

1. We must remember our Primary Mission-

Luke 4:18–20 (NIV)

¹⁸“The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor.

He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to set the oppressed free, to proclaim the year of the Lord’s favor.” ²⁰Then he rolled up the scroll, gave it back to the attendant and sat down. The eyes of everyone in the synagogue were fastened on him.

Luke 19:10 (NIV) For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost.”
