We suffer needlessly with not being renewed

Greek word- “Anakainoo” being renewed, to grow, to receive new strength and vigor; New life, consistent change.

1. We must intentionally look to see Christ in others.

Key: *Get outside yourself*

- See Jesus in the lives of others
- Appreciate others’ lives, walks, struggles, character, personality.

2. We must intentionally look to see Christ Daily

Key: *Live in a state of gratitude*

- God is at work in the mundane and normal
- Every day in an opportunity
- Living in a mindset of gratitude opens doors.

3. We must intentionally focus to see Christ in us.

Key: *Practice the things that reveal Christ.*

- See Him in His blessings
- Daily meet with him
- Listen for His Leadings
- Enjoy His gifts (nature, family, hobby, peace)
