On the road God uses specific moments to get our attention.

- The Supernatural (Halted the sun and moon for 24 hours for Joshua, The fiery furnace, Jonah, Virgin Birth, etc.)
- The Ordinary (Spoken in a still, small voice, sleepless nights, conversations of Jesus)

God is trying to get our attention, so we stop and move closer to Him.

Exodus 1-3

The burning bush was used to get Moses to listen to the word of God.

Exodus 3:4-6

⁴When the Lord saw Moses coming to take a closer look, God called to him from the middle of the bush, “Moses! Moses!”

“Here I am!” Moses replied.

⁵“Do not come any closer,” the Lord warned. “Take off your sandals, for you are standing on holy ground. ⁶I am the God of your father^[a]—the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.” When Moses heard this, he covered his face because he was afraid to look at God.
