1 Peter 1.17-19 NASB ONScreen

Teaching Points We address YHWH with family Terms Father. 252 in the NT alone.

“You shall teach them diligently to your sons and shall talk of them when you sit in your house and when you walk by the way and when you lie down and when you rise up.” (Deuteronomy 6:7, NASB95)

1. Live as an Alien

Paraoudkias-Strangers, citizens of somewhere else dwelling in a strange land.

Our world is strange. We don't belong .

2. Live in reverent fear,

Phobos- Not a fear because of a psychological and physical problem but a healthy fear. A reverence and understanding of God's awesome power, His ways, His judgement.

“The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge; Fools despise wisdom and instruction.” (Proverbs 1:7, NASB95)

“Let all the earth fear the LORD; Let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of Him.” (Psalm 33:8, NASB95)

“The secret of the LORD is for those who fear Him, And He will make them know His covenant.” (Psalm 25:14, NASB95)

“In all this, they are surprised that you do not run with them into the same excesses of dissipation, and they malign you; but they will give account to Him who is ready to judge the living and the dead.” (1 Peter 4:4-5, NASB95)

“Remember the day you stood before the LORD your God at Horeb, when the LORD said to me, ‘Assemble the people to Me, that I may let them hear My words so they may learn to fear Me all the days they live on the earth, and that they may teach their children.’” (Deuteronomy 4:10, NASB95)

“in the future there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day; and not only to me, but also to all who have loved His appearing.” (2 Timothy 4:8, NASB95)

3. Live redeemed (Lytroo in the Greek)

“knowing that you were not redeemed with perishable things like silver or gold from your futile way of life inherited from your forefathers,” (1 Peter 1:18, NASB95)

Redeemed means To set free, deliver, rescue, liberate!

- From Futile ways (ways that accomplish nothing with God.)
- Handed down from your forefathers
- By the precious Blood of the Lamb

“Your lamb shall be an unblemished male a year old; you may take it from the sheep or from the goats.”
(Exodus 12:5, NASB95)

Isaiah 53

Revelation 5.1-6

Revelation 5.12 *“Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing.”* (Revelation 5:12, NASB95)

These verses teach us:

1. **Live as people who don't belong**
2. **Live in Reverent Fear**
3. **Live Redeemed by Christ**
4. **Live for Christ, Live With Christ, Live Like Christ**
