- 1. If you want to be content, you got to be a giver. (vs. 11) Acts 20:35 ... 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.'
- 2. If you want to be content, you have to know what it's like to "go without." (vs. 12)
 - a. Well fed
 - b. Hungry
 - c. Having plenty
 - d. Going without *Philippians 4:14* "It was good for you to share in my troubles."
- 3. Contentment Bandits
 - a. Envy

James 3:16 For where envy and self-seeking exist, confusion and every evil thing are there.

b. Love of Money. (stuff)

Hebrews 13:5 Let your conduct be without covetousness; be content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you."

I Timothy 6:10 For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil, for which some have strayed from the faith in their greediness, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.

*If you are not happy with what you've got you won't be happy with what you get.

- c. Greed (see above)
- d. Comparisons
- e. Being upset when there is a guest preacher instead of Pastor Nate.
- 4. We endure hardship, persecution and sad situations through our relationship in Jesus. (vs. 13) *Philippians 4:13* NLT "For I can do everything through Christ, who gives me strength."
- 5. Walking out God's Will of contentment.
 - a. No slap backs.

I Thessalonians 5:15 See that no one renders evil for evil to anyone, but always pursue what is good both for yourselves and for all.

- b. Be kind to our church family and everyone else.
- c. Be Joyful.

I Thessalonians 5:16 Rejoice always,

- d. Pray, pray, pray. Pray some more. *I Thessalonians 5:17* pray without ceasing
- e. Rise above circumstances with gratefulness. *I Thessalonians 5:18* in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.

- 3. Share.
