Matthew 6:9-13

The purpose of the Lord's prayer, any prayer is to be heard by the Father Shema-to hear and obey

James 4:3 – "You ask and do not receive, because you ask amiss, that you may spend it on your pleasures"

"Hallowed be Thy Name" or Holy is Your Name About YHWH

1. God's Name is the revelation of who He is.

2. We are marked with God's Name

A) When we called on the name of the Lord for Salvation

"That if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved; for with the heart a person believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation." Romans 10:9–10 (NASB95)

- B) When we were baptized- a big point of water baptism is publically identifying with Jesus.
- C) When we adopted into the family of God, we take His name.

3. We represent His Name

How we live our lives is a reflection on how holy God's name is to you.

Why would a believer choose to not identify and represent the Name of the Lord? 2 Reasons...

- Ashamed "For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek." Romans 1:16 (NASB95)
 - "For whoever is ashamed of Me and My words, the Son of Man will be ashamed of him when He comes in His glory, and the glory of the Father and of the holy angels." Luke 9:26, (NASB95)
- We aren't living like we believe what Jesus lived for- "Therefore, since we have so great a cloud of witnesses surrounding us, let us also lay aside every encumbrance and the sin which so easily entangles us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us," Hebrews 12:1, (NASB95)
