### **Five Components of the Kingdom of God**

1. The Kingdom of God is highly relational.
2. The Kingdom of God is mostly unseen.
3. The Kingdom of God is within us.
4. The Kingdom of God is living in the presence and under the Lordship of Jesus Christ.
5. The Kingdom of God will bring change to those that wholeheartedly, with attentive awareness, live within it, all the time.

1. Living for Jesus.
2. Living Like Jesus.
3. Living with Jesus.

### **Manifestations of Living With Jesus**

1. An awareness of the unseen Kingdom

*"Therefore we do not lose heart, but though our outer man is decaying, yet our inner man is being renewed day by day. For momentary, light affliction is producing for us an eternal weight of glory far beyond all comparison, while we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen; for the things which are seen are temporal, but the things which are not seen are eternal."* (2 Corinthians 4:16–18, NASB95)

2. Deepening friendship

*"No longer do I call you slaves, for the slave does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all things that I have heard from My Father I have made known to you."* (John 15:15, NASB95)

3. Concentrated time together

*"In the early morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house, and went away to a secluded place, and was praying there."* (Mark 1:35, NASB95)

4. He is always with you

*"for in Him we live and move and exist, as even some of your own poets have said, 'For we also are His children.'" (Acts 17:28, NASB95)*

5. You will constantly be formed.

*"For I am confident of this very thing, that He who began a good work in you will perfect it until the day of Christ Jesus."* (Philippians 1:6, NASB95)

6. The Fruit of the Spirit will become you

*"But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things, there is no law."* (Galatians 5:22–23, NASB95)

7. Your Life will be Missional

*"You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden; nor does anyone light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on the lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. "Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven." MT 5.14-17*
