Discussion title: Resurrection Sunday

<u>Content</u>

We look at the scriptures about Jesus resurrection. The Pharisees put a guard at the tomb to make sure the disciples wouldn't steal Jesus' body and claim He was resurrected. Then an angel appeared and the guards was filled with fear. The angel told Mary Magdelene and the other Mary that Jesus was already risen and they should tell the disciples.

The guards fled and told the Pharisees what happened, and they instructed them to spread a lie that the disciples stole the body and now claim He was resurrected.

We are also looking at the powerful meaning of resurrection for us as people. It means we are spiritually resurrected after the fall of Adam and Eve.

We are also exploring things, dreams or relationships that we feel died, and we need to trust God for resurrection in it.

- What have you given up on that you want to prophecy over to be made alive in Jesus name?

We should be mindful to put as much gratitude and weight on the resurrection Sunday as we do on good Friday when the crucifixion took place.

Practical exercise

Make a note on your phone of what you are trusting for in terms of resurrection, let the group know when it realizes.

<u>Application</u>

Meditate on the fact that you are spiritually alive.

Prayer and encouragement

Pray for each other in the group and prophecy over the desires for resurrection.
