## 1. RECAP

**Ephesians 1:22-23** "... and God placed all things under his feet, and he appointed Jesus to be the head over everything for the church, which is his body, the fullness of him who fills everything in every way."

**Ephesians 2:10 (NLT)** "For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago."

- 1.1. **BE** – Workmanship: Who am I created to be? A son of God and a disciple of Jesus.
- 1.2. **DO** – Good works: What am I called to do? Core mission is to make disciples.
- 1.3. **GO** – In advance: Where am I called to go? Core position is to GO to opportunities where we live, work and play.

## 2. SPIRITUAL GROWTH CHART (THE 5 "E'S")

- **ENCOUNTER (RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD)**
- **ENGAGE (RELATIONSHIP WITH CHURCH)**
- **EQUIP (DISCIPLESHIP AND TEACHING)**
- **EMPOWER (MINISTRY IN CHURCH)**
- **EXPORT (MISSION OUT THERE)**

- 2.1. It is important to note the goal is to have a balance between the 5 bases. People tend to nurture what they like instead of what is needed to grow spiritually in a balanced way.

## 3. EXPORT (GO)

- 3.1. Export is not just one more thing that has to be added to your already over extended life.
- 3.2. Rather, it is finding something you enjoy, that you feel passionate about, and using that to change the world.

**Ephesians 5:8 (NIV)** "For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Live as children of light"

**Ephesians 5:14-15 (NIV)** "This is why it is said: "Wake up, sleeper, rise from the dead, and Christ will shine on you." 15 Be very careful, then, how you live—not as unwise but as wise..."

**Isaiah 60:1 (NIV)** "Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord rises upon you.
