- Commit to supporting and encouraging one another in developing and utilizing your gifts for God's Kingdom.
- 9. **Closing Prayer**: Close the discussion with a prayer of gratitude for the talents and opportunities God has given each member of the group and ask for strength and wisdom to be faithful stewards of these gifts.
