1.1. Everything about our lives revolves around our thoughts.

2.1. I know God's purpose for my life.

John 8:14 (NIV) "... I know where I came from and where I am going."

Luke 2:49 (KJV) "I must be about my Father's business."

John 10:10 (NLT) "My purpose is to give life in all its fullness."

2.2. I am always aware that God is with me.

John 16:32 "I am not alone because the Father is always with me."

Luke 5:15-16 (NCV)"Jesus often slipped away to be alone so he could pray."

2.3. I let God help me choose my words.

John 12:49 (GW) "I have not spoken on my own. Instead, the Father who sent me tells me <u>what I should say and how I should say it</u>."

2.4. I don't worry about pleasing everyone.

John 5:30 (NCV) "I only try to please the One who sent me."

Luke 16:13 (NIV) "No one can serve two masters . . . "

2.5. I depend on God's power instead of my own.

John 5:19 (NIV) "I assure you, the Son can <u>do nothing by himself</u>. He can only do what he sees his Father doing . . ."

2.6. I forgive my enemies and those who hurt me.

Luke 23:34 (NIV) "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing."

Matthew 5:44 (KJV) "<u>Love</u> your enemies, <u>bless</u> those who curse you, <u>do good</u> to those who hate you, <u>and pray</u> for those which despitefully use you orpersecute you."

2.7. I am willing to sacrifice for others.

John 10:14-15 (NLT) "I am the good shepherd...and I lay down my life for the sheep."

Mark 10:45 "<u>I came</u> here not to be served but <u>to serve others</u>, and <u>to give</u> my life as a ransom for many."

1 John 3:16 "This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us. And we ought to lay down our lives for each other."

Mark 14:36 (NLT) "Abba, Father, everything is possible for you. Please take this cup of suffering away from me. Yet <u>I want your will to be done</u>, not mine."
