1 John 3:1 (NIV) "See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are! The reason the world does not know us is that it did not know him."

### 1. GOD IS A CARING FATHER

Matthew 6:31-32 (NIV) "So don't worry saying, 'What shall we eat? ... or what shall we wear?' ... Your heavenly Father knows you need these things."

#### 2. GOD IS A CONSISTENT FATHER

James 1:17 (NIV) "Every good and perfect gift... is from <u>the Father</u> ... who <u>does not</u> <u>change</u> like shifting shadows."

2 Timothy 2:13 (NIV) "Even if we are faithless, He <u>remains faithful</u>, for He cannot disown Himself."

Romans 11:29 (LB) "God will never go back on His promises."

Psalm 59:10 (LB) "My God is <u>changeless in His love</u> for me."

#### 3. GOD IS A FATHER WHO IS CLOSE

Acts 17:27 (NIV) "God did this so people would ... reach out for Him and find Him, since <u>He</u> is not far from each of us."

**3.1.** He is never too busy for you.

Psalm 145:18 (NIV) "The Lord is near to all who call on Him."

**3.2.** He loves to meet your needs.

Matthew 7:11 (NIV) "If you... know how to give good gifts to your children, <u>how much</u> <u>more</u> will your Father in heaven give good gifts to those who ask Him!"

**3.3.** He is sympathetic to your hurts.

Psalm 34:18 (NIV) "The Lord is <u>close</u> to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit."

#### 4. GOD IS A COMPETENT FATHER

Luke 1:37 (NIV) "For <u>nothing</u> is impossible with God."

Ephesians 3:20 (LB) "(God) is able to do <u>far more</u> than we would ever dare to ask to even dream of – infinitely beyond our highest prayers, desires, thoughts, or hopes!"
