# Why you absolutely need a church family

#### 1. WHAT IS CHURCH?

- **1.1.** Church is not a building or an institution or an event to attend. Church is a spiritual family that you belong to.
- **1.2.** A CHURCH is a group of baptized believers who've joined together in a commitment to help each other fulfill God's five purposes for their lives.

Acts 2:41-42, 46 (NLT/LB) "Those who <u>BELIEVED</u>...were <u>BAPTIZED</u> and <u>ADDED to the church</u>...They <u>JOINED</u> with the other believers and <u>COMMITTED THEMSELVES</u> to the apostles' <u>teaching</u>, <u>and to the fellowship</u>... They <u>worshiped together</u> regularly at the Temple courts and <u>met in small groups in homes</u> for <u>communion</u>, and <u>shared</u> meals with great joy and thankfulness."

#### 2. WHY IS THE CHURCH THE MOST IMPORTANT GROUP ON EARTH?

- **2.1.** The Church is God's family.
  - 1 Peter 1:3 "God has given us the privilege of being born again so that we are now MEMBERS of GOD'S OWN FAMILY."
  - 1 Timothy 3:15 (NCV) "That family is the church of the living God, the support and foundation of the truth."
- **2.2.** The Church is the reason God created the universe.

Ephesians 1:4 (LB) "Long ago, even before he made the world, God chose us to be his very own through what Christ would do for us."

Ephesians 1:5 (NLT) "His unchanging plan has always been to adopt us into his own family by bringing us to Himself through Jesus Christ. And this gave him great pleasure."

**2.3.** The Church is God's agent on earth for His purposes.

Ephesians 3:10-11 "God's intent was that now, <u>THROUGH THE CHURCH</u>, the manifold wisdom of God should be made known to all the rulers and authorities in the heavenly realms, <u>according to his eternal purpose</u> which he accomplished in Christ Jesus our Lord."

Ephesians 3:10 (MSG) "Through Christians like yourselves gathered in churches, this extraordinary plan of God is becoming known and talked about even among the angels!"

**2.4.** Jesus died for His Church.

Ephesians 5:25, 27 (NCV) "Christ <u>loved the church and gave Himself for it</u>... <u>he died</u> so that he could give <u>the church</u> to Himself like a bride in all her beauty. he died <u>so that</u> the church could be pure and without fault..."

**2.5.** Only the Church will last forever.

Ephesians 3:21 (GW) "Glory will belong to God in his church and in Christ Jesus for all time and eternity!"

- 1 Thessalonians 4:17 "...we will be with the Lord together forever!"
- **2.6.** Only the Church will ultimately win against evil.

Matthew 16:18 (NLT) Jesus: "I will build my church, and all the powers of hell will not conquer it!"

**2.7.** Only the Church is big enough to solve global problems.

Ephesians 3:20 (NLT) "By his mighty power at work within us, God is able to accomplish infinitely more than we would ever dare to ask or hope!"

- **2.8.** Belonging to God's Church is the greatest privilege.
  - 1 Peter 1:3 "God has given us the privilege of being born again so that we are now members of God's own family."
  - 1 Corinthians 3:16 "Don't you realize that <u>ALL OF YOU TOGETHER</u> are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God lives in you?"
