Matthew 6

**WHAT DID JESUS TEACH WHEN HE WAS ON EARTH?
JESUS TAUGHT ABOUT GOD AND HIS KINGDOM. HE TAUGHT THAT ALL
SCRIPTURE IS ABOUT HIM.**

Great crowds of people followed Jesus. One day, Jesus went up on a mountain and began to teach.

Jesus said, "When you give to people who are poor, give in secret. And when you pray, don't pray just so that people will hear you."

Jesus taught the people how to pray: "Our Father in heaven, Your name be honored as holy. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. And do not bring us into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one."

He also said, "Forgive others. If you forgive those who sin against you, God will forgive you too. But if you don't forgive them, God will not forgive you."

Jesus said, "Do not collect treasures on earth. Collect treasures in heaven instead. For where your treasure is, that is where your heart will be also."

Jesus also taught that God provides for His people. "Don't worry about your life or what you will eat or drink or wear. Seek the kingdom of God and His righteousness first, and all these things that you need will be given to you."

Jesus taught many things about how people in His kingdom should live. When He finished teaching, the crowds were amazed.

Christ Connection: Jesus taught people what it means to follow Him. He taught how people should interact with God and others. Believers live to honor God—not to earn God's favor but because they already have it.
