**HOW DO WE KNOW THAT GOD WANTS US TO KNOW HIM?
WE CAN KNOW THAT GOD WANTS US TO KNOW HIM BECAUSE HE HAS
REVEALED HIMSELF THROUGH HIS WORD.**

After Jesus had been raised from the dead, He met with His disciples over the next 40 days. During that time, Jesus told them even more about God's kingdom. Jesus told His eleven disciples to go to a mountain in Galilee, so they did. They saw Jesus there, and they worshiped Him.

Jesus went up to them and said, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth." Jesus is the King over all creation, and He rules over God's kingdom.

Jesus gave the disciples—and everyone who follows Him—a job to do. He said, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel. Make disciples of people from every nation."

Jesus also said, "Baptize them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit."

Jesus continued, "Teach them to obey everything I have commanded you." Then Jesus said, "Remember this: I am always with you, until the very end of the age."

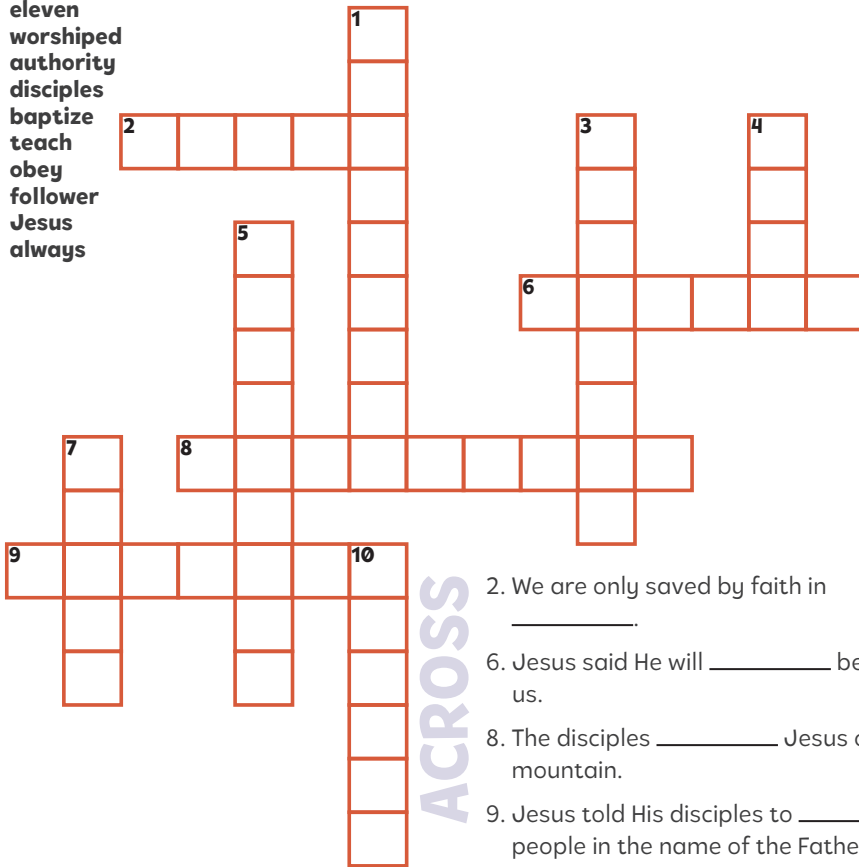
