Matthew 23

HOW IS JESUS THE PERFECT PROPHET? JESUS PERFECTLY REVEALS GOD THE FATHER AND FULFILLS WHAT THE PROPHETS SPOKE.

One day, Jesus spoke to the crowds of people and to His followers. He said, "The religious leaders tell you about God's law that came through Moses. You should obey this law." Then He told them, "But do not be like the religious leaders because they tell you to do one thing, but they don't do it themselves. They make up hard rules for you to follow, but they do not follow their own rules."

Jesus said that the religious leaders did everything so that other people would think they were great.


"You have one Teacher," Jesus reminded them, "and you are all brothers and sisters. You have one Father—God—who is in heaven. Whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and whoever humbles himself will be exalted."

Jesus warned the religious leaders, "You convince people to follow you, but you lead them away from God. You care more about following rules than showing justice, mercy, and faithfulness."

Jesus said the religious leaders looked clean on the outside but were dirty on the inside: "You wash the outside of the cup and dish, but you are greedy and selfish."

Finally, Jesus said to the scribes and Pharisees, "Do you think you will escape God's judgment? No! You will be punished."

Christ Connection: Jesus said that the greatest commandments are to love God and love others. (Matt. 22:37-39) The religious leaders loved themselves most of all. When we trust in Jesus, He makes us right with God and changes our hearts so we can love and obey Him.
