





Unit 28 • Session 1 JESUS APPEARED TO THE DISCIPLES Luke 24

HOW DO WE KNOW THAT GOD WANTS US TO KNOW HIM? WE CAN KNOW THAT GOD WANTS US TO KNOW HIM BECAUSE HE HAS REVEALED HIMSELF THROUGH HIS WORD.

On the first day of the week, in the evening, Jesus' disciples gathered together in a house in Jerusalem. Jesus' followers reported that Jesus wasn't dead anymore. Two of Jesus' followers told the other disciples that Jesus had appeared to them on the road to Emmaus.

As the disciples talked, Jesus came and stood among them. "Peace to you!" He said.

The disciples were surprised and terrified. The disciples thought they were seeing a ghost.

"Why are you afraid?" Jesus asked. "It's Me! Why do you doubt? Look at Me and touch Me. You can see that I'm not a ghost. A ghost does not have flesh and bones like I do."


Jesus showed the disciples His hands and His side. Jesus really was alive! Jesus talked to the disciples and explained the Bible to them. He helped them understand how the Law of Moses, the Prophets, and the Psalms told about Him. The Scriptures said the Messiah would suffer and rise from the dead so that people could be forgiven for their sins. Then Jesus told the disciples that they had a job to do. The disciples needed to tell other people to repent from their sin and be forgiven.

Christ Connection: For 40 days, Jesus presented Himself to over 500 people and proved that He is alive. (1 Corinthians 15:3-8) Jesus is still alive today. He sends out believers to tell others about Him.
