## JESUS WAS BAPTIZED

Matthew 3: Mark 1

## WHAT DID JESUS DO TO SAVE US? JESUS LIVED A SINLESS LIFE, DIED ON THE CROSS, AND ROSE FROM THE DEAD.

John the Baptist lived in the wilderness. John began telling people, "Repent and be baptized because God's kingdom is almost here."

Long before John was born, the prophet Isaiah said, "Prepare the way for the Lord; make His paths straight!" Isaiah was talking about John. John had a very important job. He was supposed to get people ready for Jesus—God's promised Messiah.

People started to repent; they turned away from their sins and turned to God for forgiveness. Then John baptized them in the Jordan River.

John preached, "Someone greater than me is coming. I baptize you with water, but He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit." John was talking about Jesus.

When John saw Jesus, he said, "Here is the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!"

Jesus told John that He wanted to be baptized. But John didn't think he should baptize Jesus. John was confused. He baptized people who confessed their sins; Jesus never sinned!

Jesus said, "Allow Me to be baptized. God says this is right." So John agreed, and he baptized Jesus.

God's voice came from heaven. "This is My Son," the voice said. "I love Him, and I am very pleased with Him!"

Christ Connection: Jesus never sinned, but He obeyed God and was baptized like sinners are baptized. Baptism reminds us of Jesus' death and resurrection. It reminds us that when we trust in Jesus, we turn from sin and start a new life—a life lived for Jesus.
