## The Lord's Supper [Mark 14:22-31](#)

The Lord's Supper is a \_\_\_\_\_  
instituted by Christ to commemorate His atoning death that established the New covenant. The Church solemnly partakes of bread and juice / wine. The elements represent Christ's body and blood. Believers examine themselves and repent of sin to assure their hearts are right with God. As they partake, they reaffirm their faith in Jesus Christ as Lord and proclaim the Gospel.

1. **Transubstantiation** = the bread & wine \_\_\_\_\_  
the body & blood of Jesus when the Priest blesses them
