Big idea

God hears the prayers of His children, offered in faith, and He answers every one of them.

How to pray

1. Make your _____ to God.

So to keep me from becoming conceited because of the surpassing greatness of the revelations, a thorn was given me in the flesh, a messenger of Satan to harass me, to keep me from becoming conceited. Three times I pleaded with the Lord about this, that it should leave me. *2 Corinthians 12:7-8 (ESV)*

2. Receive God's _____.

But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly of my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may rest upon me. *2 Corinthians 12:9 (ESV)*

Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. *Matthew 6:10 (ESV)*

saying, "Father, if you are willing, remove this cup from me. Nevertheless, not my will, but yours, be done." *Luke 22:42 (ESV)*

3. Live in light of what we have _____.

For the sake of Christ, then, I am content with weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions, and calamities. For when I am weak, then I am strong. *2 Corinthians 12:10 (ESV)*
