**Text:** John 2:12-25

### **Passover**

- Celebrating death angel "passing over" the houses of the Israelites in Egypt
- Jesus' family went to Jerusalem for Passover every year
- John mentions all three Passover celebrations during the ministry of Jesus (1:13, 6:4, 12:1)
- By Jewish law every male within 15 miles of Jerusalem was required to come to the city for Passover
- During Passover, Jerusalem a city of 200,000, swelled to 2 mil
