"GENEROUS"

Part Three "Tithe & Offering: The First Steps of Generous"

2 Corinthians 9:6-11 (NIV)

Verse 11: "You will be made rich in every way so that you can be generous on every occasion, and through us your generosity will result in thanksgiving to God."

INTRODUCTION:

Generous: giving or bestowing liberally and unselfishly; abundant; plentiful

Luke 12:16-21

- * Three Observations:
 - 1. This man was selfish, not generous. (Luke 12:16-19)
 - 2. God called him a fool. (Luke 12:20)
 - 3. Being generous starts by giving to God. (Luke 12:21)

Tithe: a tenth; to pay or give the tenth portion; to tithe as a debtor.

Offering: <u>a present as in a sacrifice or tribute; to bear towards; to tender to God as a presentation or sacrifice</u>.

• The tithe and the offering are looked upon by God as <u>first fruits</u>. (*Proverbs 3:9-10; Leviticus 27:30-32*)

Joshua 6:1-2, 15-29

- * Four Observations:
 - 1. <u>Jericho was a gift of God's generosity</u>. (Joshua 6:2)
 - 2. God required them to pay tithes and give offerings. (Joshua 6:18-29)
 - Jericho: <u>a place of fragrance</u>(Exodus 29:18; Leviticus 1:9; Numbers 28:1-2)
 - 3. <u>Israel was unfaithful in tithes and offerings</u>. (Joshua 7:1)
 - 4. Their unfaithfulness brought about a curse. (Joshua 7:11-12)
- * Withholding the Tithe and Offering Causes God's People To:
 - Become Afraid.
 - 2. Be Set Apart For Destruction.
 - Feel Alone and Without God.

Joshua 7:12 (NIV)

12 That is why the Israelites cannot stand against their enemies; they turn their backs and run because they have been made liable to destruction. I will not be with you anymore unless you destroy whatever among you is devoted to destruction.

Malachi 3:6-12 (NIV)... 6 "I the LORD do not change.
