

**The Evidence of the Resurrection: Living in Resurrection
Victory
5-Day Devotional Guide**

Day 1: Christ the Conqueror

Reading: Colossians 2:13-15

Devotional

The resurrection wasn't just Jesus returning to life—it was a declaration of total victory. When Christ stepped out of that tomb, He disarmed every spiritual power that held humanity captive. The cross looked like defeat, but it was actually the battlefield where sin, death, and Satan were conquered. You're not living under the shadow of what the enemy can do; you're living in the light of what Christ has already done. Today, whatever battle you're facing, remember: you're not fighting for victory, you're fighting from victory. Jesus didn't just survive death—He destroyed it. Because He conquered, you are more than a conqueror.

Day 2: Undeniable Evidence

Reading: Luke 24:36-43

Devotional

Jesus didn't ask His disciples to believe blindly. He showed them His hands and feet. He ate with them. He invited them to touch His scars. God is not intimidated by your questions or doubts. He meets you where you are with evidence of His presence and power. The same Jesus who proved Himself alive to Thomas will prove Himself faithful to you. Your faith doesn't rest on emotion or tradition—it stands on the solid foundation of a resurrected Savior. When doubt creeps in, remember: Jesus specializes in turning skeptics into worshipers. Invite Him into your uncertainty and watch Him reveal Himself in undeniable ways.

Day 3: Personal Encounter

Reading: John 20:11-18

Devotional

Jesus called Mary by name, and everything changed. The resurrection isn't a distant historical event—it's a personal encounter waiting to happen in your life today. Jesus doesn't just want you

to know about Him; He wants you to know Him. He sees you in your grief, confusion, and searching. He speaks your name with intimate knowledge and transforming love. Christianity isn't about learning facts; it's about experiencing the living Christ. Today, pause and listen. He's calling your name. He's revealing Himself not to the crowds first, but to individuals who seek Him with sincere hearts. Your relationship with Jesus is personal, intentional, and transformative.

Day 4: Intentional Preparation

Reading: Acts 1:1-8

Devotional

Jesus spent forty days after His resurrection preparing His disciples. He didn't just prove He was alive and leave—He stayed until their faith was anchored and their mission was clear. God is intentional about your spiritual formation. He doesn't rush your growth or abandon you in confusion. He opens your understanding, restores what's broken, and equips you with power for purpose. If you feel like you're in a season of waiting, recognize it as divine preparation. Jesus is establishing your faith, clarifying your calling, and positioning you for kingdom impact. Trust the process. What God is doing in you during this season will sustain what He does through you in the next.

Day 5: Victory Declared

Reading: 1 Corinthians 15:50-58

Devotional

"Death, where is your sting? Grave, where is your victory?" Because Jesus rose, everything changed. The resurrection isn't just about life after death—it's about victorious life right now. You don't have to live defeated, discouraged, or dominated by fear. The same power that raised Christ from the dead is available to you today. Every chain the enemy uses to bind you has already been broken. Every weapon formed against you has already been defeated. Stand firm in this truth: you are more than a conqueror through Christ who loves you. Your labor in the Lord is not in vain. Live today with resurrection confidence, knowing that because He lives, you can face tomorrow. _
