Remembering God's blessings reminds us to praise Him.

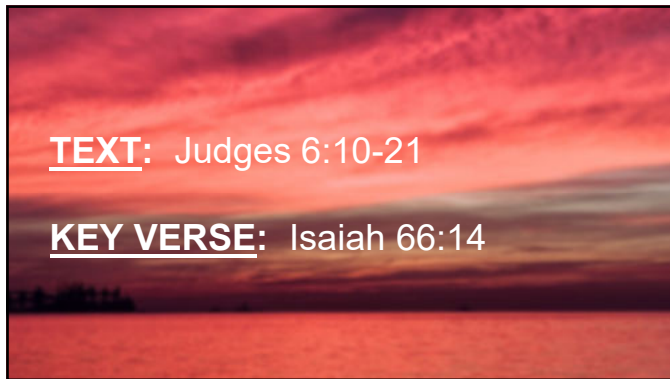
