A Place to Become 1 John 3:1-3

Introduction:

"Grace is God loving, God Stooping, God coming to the rescue, God giving himself generously in and through Jesus Christ." - John Stott

"This "Father" business isn't mere religious talk or an attempt to tap into the power of positive thinking. If you are a Christian, you have a perfect heavenly Father who loves you and who doesn't share any of the failures of your earthly father." - Tony Evans

I. Our God given position before the Father.

A. We have been selected by the Father.

1 John 3:1 Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God:

- His manner of love is revealed in the condition He loved us; **Romans 5:8** *But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.*
- His manner of love is revealed in the position He placed us; Titus 3:7 *That being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life.*
- His manner of love is revealed in the family He gives us; Romans 8:17 And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ;
 - B. We are slighted by the world.

1 John 3:1... therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew him not.

II. Our God given potential before the Father.

A. What we can anticipate in our future.

1 John 3:2 Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be:

"He meant us to see Him and live with Him and draw our life from His smile." - A.W. Tozer

"We are to live in the atmosphere of His love. "

B. What we can actualize in our faith.

1 John 3:2 . . . but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.

- Crucifying the flesh makes us like Him; Galatians 2:20 I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me:
- Living by faith makes us like Him; Galatians 2:20 ... and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.
- Suffering makes us like Him; Philippians 3:10 That I may know him, and the power of his resurrection, and the fellowship of his sufferings, being made conformable unto his death;

III. Our God given practice before the Father.

"Remember one day every one of God's Children will be with Jesus and be like Him—resurrected and without sin."

A. We are to live in an atmosphere of hope.

1 John 3:3 And every man that hath this hope in him . . .

B. We are to live in actions of holiness.

1 John 3:3 ... purifieth himself, even as he is pure.

1 Peter 1:15 But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation; (V.16) Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy.
