

# The Potter's House

Hebrews 10:19-25 **Sunday, June 9, 2024** 

#### **Introduction:**

## Why is it important for the Potter to bring the clay back to His house?

- He brings it back to claim it for His own.
  1 Corinthians 6:20 For ye are bought with a price:
- He brings it back so He can put His name upon it.

  Romans 9:17 ... Even for this same purpose have I raised thee up, that I might shew my power in thee, and that my name might be declared throughout all the earth.
- He brings it back so He might express His glory through it.
  2 Thessalonians 1:12 That the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in you, and ye in him,
  - I. There is a new atmosphere in the Potter's house. (V19-21)
    - A. It is an atmosphere of companionship.

Hebrews 10:19 Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus,

B. It is an atmosphere of ownership.

Hebrews 10:20 By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh; (V.21) And having an high priest over the house of God;

Romans 14:7 For none of us liveth to himself, and no man dieth to himself. (V.8) For whether we live, we live unto the Lord; and whether we die, we die unto the Lord: whether we live therefore, or die, we are the Lord's.

# II. There is a new allegiance in the house. (V.22-23)

A. It is an allegiance that draws us closer to Christ.

Hebrews 10:22 Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water.

- B. What does our church attendance expresses to Christ?
- Church attendance is a gesture of sincerity. It demonstrates our determination to follow through with our commitment. (V.22)
- Church attendance is a grateful response to the gracious actions of the Potter's help. (V.22)
- Church attendance is a demonstration of our sincerity to receive cleansing and healing from the Potter. (V.22)
- Church attendance is an expression of conformation that we are glad He has freed us. (V.22)
- Church attendance is an acknowledgment of what we have received and an indication of our desire to have more. (V.23)

### III. There is a new alliance in the Potter's house. (V.24-25)

"It has been said of some that they have a green thumb in the world of plant life, but God has called us to have a green thumb in the garden of human life."

A. It is an alliance of enablement.

Hebrews 10:24 And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works:

#### What do we do for each other in the Potter's house?

- It is to be a place where we recognize the value of a Godly influence and become conscious of our effect on others. (V.24)
- It is to be a place where we strive to promote and forward the ministry of Christ's love. (V.24)
- It is a place where we are conscious of the soon coming of Christ and we live our lives accordingly. (V.25)

Ephesians 5:26 That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, (V.27) That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.

B. It is an alliance of encouragement.

Hebrews 10:25 Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.
