God's Story reveals our need for a redeemer and our great hope that the redeemer has come in the person of Jesus Christ. God's Story is the story that makes sense of all other stories... including yours.



The greatest "epoch" humankind can ever know is the story of God's relationship with us. You find this epoch revealed in the pages of God's Word—the Bible. The Bible contains an Upper Story and a Lower Story. — The Upper Story tells the big picture, the grand narrative of God seeking relationship with humankind as it unfolds throughout history.

- The Lower Story contains the details of particular people, the episodes we've become familiar with: Adam and Eve, Moses, the flood, etc.
- The Upper Story is really a framework around which we approach and apply any one part of the Bible. It unifies God's message to us and helps guide us through the hard times in life by doing two things:
- a) reminding us of God's eternal, longrange plan and,
- b) putting our experiences into a divine context formed by a perfect

Creator.

For example, without the Upper Story, a lost job could be seen as an event without hope. But put into the context of the larger chronicle of our lives, and God's perfect design, that lost job can be seen in a very different light... perhaps as an opportunity for God to reveal something better.

By putting all we read into the larger picture, we can make modern-day application from the Bible that takes into account the grand, mysterious ways of God, and guards us from misapplications that can result from an isolated "what this verse says to me" approach. And in every situation, the Upper Story always creates the context for the Lower Story.

For Hilltop Church, we want to use "God's Story, Our Story" to help everyone gain a better understanding of the Jesus Christ that Scripture reveals and who we are in Him, as we focus our lives and relationships on the main story of God's rescue, His redemption, and His restoration of humanity. The many stories of our lives and this world only begin to make sense when we understand the complete Story of God. And as we journey together through "God's Story, Our Story," our prayer is that you will find your place in God's redemptive story as well!

A word about this story of "epoch" proportions:

The Bible wasn't written all at once, but over a period of more than 1,000 years. Its contents cover a variety of ancient peoples and cultures, and so we need a sense of the historical and cultural contexts in which the parts were written. Without this context we risk misunderstanding the Bible's message. This chronological study of the Bible will take you on a journey through the history and culture of the Bible and allow you to step back into biblical times and discover the world out of which the Bible grew. It will help you follow the flow of events in the Scriptures and see where sacred and secular history converge into one story of lesus Christ and salvation.

A story so grand can be overwhelming in scope. So, our study is divided into nine "epochs," or periods of time, that are characterized by specific features or events.

Epoch One: Before the Patriarchs (Creation—2000 B.C.)

Humankind's earliest ancestors appear in what is called "prehistory" -- before events were recorded. Then humans pioneered writing, and "history" began.
