Revelation 10 "A Fathers Instructions"

Main Point: Your reaction to God's Word indicates whether it speaks of your deliverance or judgment.

I. There is nowhere that God's Word and authority does not apply (vv. 1–3).

Deuteronomy 11:24, "Every place on which the sole of your foot treads shall be yours." Joshua 10:24; Psalm 8:6, "you have put all things under his feet" 1 Corinthians 15:27, "For "God has put all things in subjection under his feet." Joel 3:16, "The Lord roars from Zion, and utters His voice from Jerusalem, and the heavens and the earth quake." Isaiah 29:5–6

II. God decides when enough warning is enough (vv. 4–7).

Deuteronomy 32:40–41, "For I lift up my hand to heaven and swear, As I live forever, if I sharpen my flashing sword and my hand takes hold on judgment, I will take vengeance on my adversaries and will repay those who hate me." Daniel 12:6–7

III. God's Word is sweeter than honey, but the world's rejection of it is painful (vv. 8–11).

Psalm 119:103, "How sweet are your words to my taste, sweeter than honey to my mouth!"

Jeremiah 15:15–16, "O Lord, you know; remember me and visit me, and take vengeance for me on my persecutors. In your forbearance take me not away; know that for your sake I bear reproach. Your words were found, and I ate them, and your words became to me a joy and the delight of my heart, for I am called by your name, O Lord, God of hosts."
