Revelation 11:1–19 "And He shall reign forever and ever..."

Main Point: God will protect His people against Satanic opposition and they will declare the gospel until the kingdom comes.

I. We triumph as God protects us while we share the gospel (vv. 1–6).

Revelation 21:22, "And I saw no Temple in the city, for its Temple is the Lord God almighty and the Lamb." Hebrews 9:11–12, "But when Christ appeared as a high priest of the good things that have come, then through the greater and more perfect tent (not made with hands, that is, not of this creation) ¹² he entered once for all into the holy places, not by means of the blood of goats and calves but by means of his own blood, thus securing an eternal redemption." John 2:19; 1 Corinthians 3:16

II. Satan's torment on the church is short lived (vv. 7–14).

Psalm 79:1–5; Ezekiel 37:5, "Thus says the Lord God to these bones: Behold, I will cause breath to enter you, and you shall live." Matthew 24:29–31; 2 Thessalonians 4:16, "For the Lord himself will descend from heaven with a cry of command, with the voice of an archangel, and with the sound of the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. ¹⁷ Then we who are alive, who are left, will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we will always be with the Lord."

III. God will judge the world and reward His people (vv. 14–19).
