Revelation 8:1–13 "Trumpets of Glory"

God's answer to Revelation 6:9–10, "When he opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of those who had been slaughtered because of the word of God and the testimony they had given. ¹⁰ They cried out with a loud voice, "Lord, the one who is holy and true, how long until you judge those who live on the earth and avenge our blood?"

Main Point: God answers prayer by glorifying Himself as He executes judgment on the world.

I. God will answer our prayers (vv. 1–5).

Habakkuk 2:20, "But the Lord is in his holy temple; let the whole earth be silent in his presence."

Romans 12:19, "Friends, do not avenge yourselves; instead, leave room for God's wrath, because it is written, Vengeance belongs to me; I will repay, says the Lord."

II. God will judge the world like He did Egypt in the Exodus (vv. 6–12).

Genesis 15:13–14; Exodus 2:23–25; Exodus 9:23–25; 1 John 5:14, "And this is the confidence that we have toward him, that if we ask anything according to his will he hears us."

III. God gives us plenty of warning (v. 13).

Romans 10:13, "All who call upon the name of the Lord will be saved."
