

Psalm 2 “Kiss the Son”

Main Point: *Submission to Christ is the greatest good.*

I. Resisting Christ is futile (vv. 1–3).

James 4:1–3; John 3:19, “¹⁹ *And this is the judgment: the light has come into the world, and people loved the darkness rather than the light because their works were evil.*” Romans 7:18

II. The Lord mocks ungodly counsel (vv. 4–6).

Hebrews 1:3; Hebrews 4:12–13

III. Christ is the undisputed King of all creation (vv. 7–9).

Hosea 11:1; Romans 1:4; Matthew 28:18–20, “¹⁸ *And Jesus came and said to them, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. ¹⁹ Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.”* Genesis 12:3, “³ *I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.*” 1 Peter 2:9; Genesis 49:10, “*The scepter shall not depart from Judah, nor the ruler's staff from between his feet, until tribute comes to him;*” Numbers 24:17

IV. Wisdom is found in submission to Christ (vv. 10–12).

Proverbs 1:7, “*The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge; fools despise wisdom and instruction.*” Matthew 10:28, “*And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather fear him who can destroy both soul and body in hell.*” Romans 10:9, “⁹ *because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.*”
