Revelation 22:1–9 "Our Greatest Blessing"

Main Point: God will keep His word and deliver His people to a new and greater Garden of Eden.

I. God's presence cleanses and heals His people (vv. 1-2).

Psalm 46:4, "There is a river whose streams make glad the city of God." Zechariah 14:8, "living waters shall flow out of Jerusalem." Ezekiel 47:12, "And on the banks, on both sides of the river, there will grow all kinds of trees for food. Their leaves will not wither, nor their fruit fail, but they will bear fresh fruit every month, because the water for them flows from the sanctuary. Their fruit will be for food, and their leaves for healing." Psalm 1:1–3, "Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the wicked, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of scoffers; but his delight is in the law of the Lord, and on his law he meditates day and night. He is like a tree planted by streams of water that yields its fruit in its season, and its leaf does not wither. In all that he does, he prospers."

II. God's presence reverses the curse (vv. 3–5).

John 17:3, "And this is eternal life, that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent."

III. God's words are faithful and true (vv. 6–9).
