

Revelation 15 “Seven Last Plagues”

Main Point: *God’s judgment means deliverance for His people.*

I. God demonstrates His glory in winning redemption and executing judgment (vv. 1–4).

Revelation 12:11, “*And they have conquered him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, for they loved not their lives even unto death.*” Ecclesiastes 12:13–14, “¹³ *The end of the matter; all has been heard. Fear God and keep his commandments, for this is the whole duty of man. ¹⁴ For God will bring every deed into judgment, with every secret thing, whether good or evil.*”

II. God’s wrath displays His glory, which means victory for His followers, and terror for the rest of the world (vv. 5–8).

Revelation 1:13, “*and in the midst of the lampstands one like a son of man, clothed with a long robe and with a golden sash around his chest.*” Psalm 79:12, “*Return sevenfold into the lap of our neighbors the taunts with which they have taunted you, O Lord!*” Isaiah 51:17, “*Wake yourself, wake yourself, stand up, O Jerusalem, you who have drunk from the hand of the Lord the cup of his wrath, who have drunk to the dregs the bowl, the cup of staggering.*” Isaiah 6:4, “*And the foundations of the thresholds shook at the voice of him who called, and the house was filled with smoke.*”
