Revelation 15 "Seven Last Plagues"

Main Point: God's judgment means deliverance for His people.

I. God demonstrates His glory in winning redemption and executing judgment (vv. 1–4).

Revelation 12:11, "And they have conquered him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, for they loved not their lives even unto death." Ecclesiastes 12:13–14, "¹³ The end of the matter; all has been heard. Fear God and keep his commandments, for this is the whole duty of man. ¹⁴ For God will bring every deed into judgment, with every secret thing, whether good or evil."

II. God's wrath displays His glory, which means victory for His followers, and terror for the rest of the world (vv. 5–8).

Revelation 1:13, "and in the midst of the lampstands one like a son of man, clothed with a long robe and with a golden sash around his chest." Psalm 79:12, "Return sevenfold into the lap of our neighbors the taunts with which they have taunted you, O Lord!" Isaiah 51:17, "Wake yourself, wake yourself, stand up, O Jerusalem, you who have drunk from the hand of the Lord the cup of his wrath, who have drunk to the dregs the bowl, the cup of staggering." Isaiah 6:4, "And the foundations of the thresholds shook at the voice of him who called, and the house was filled with smoke."
