



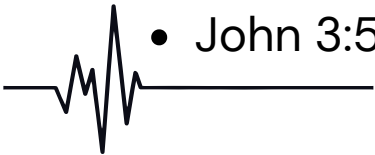
DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

In the beginning, God created us in his image to worship and glorify him. We have all sinned against God, worshiping ourselves and idols. Christ restores us to true worship.

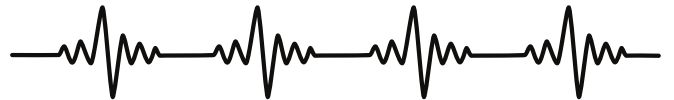
Read these verses and make notes about how they speak to your identity as a worshiper:

- What does being made “in the image of God” and “created for [his] glory” have to do with our identity as worshipers?



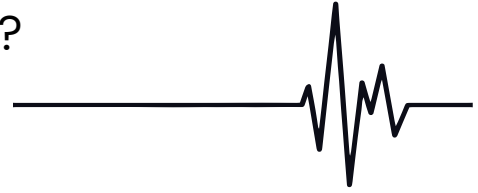
Answer after reading Romans 3:23
