DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

READ Proverbs 11:24-25

- Even though a paradox, why is it true that one can make himself rich yet have nothing, and one can make himself poor even with great riches?
- Who do you know that has lived a life of generosity? How has their generosity affected their life?



READ 2 Corinthians 8:7-9

- What was Paul asking the Corinthians to do (verse 7)?
- What two examples did Paul use to motivate them to give?
- Notice how the work of Jesus (v.9) was issued as our example and our fuel to give. How does a proper understanding of the gospel actually increase our love for God and people while decreasing our love for self and possessions?
- Share a time when you were in need and God sent aid to you.

READ James 5:1-6

- What kind of things do you value in this life?
- What investments of time and money (in general) do you most regret and why?
- How can you invest your limited time on this earth on what has eternal value?
- What can you do this week to help invest in the local church family?

LIVING IT OUT SECTION

This week think about these questions & write down your answers:

- How tightly are you holding on to what God has entrusted to you in the way of finances?
- Have you experienced the true joy of giving?
- Do you give of your first fruits or only the leftovers?
- How are you modeling a lifestyle of generosity for your children or others who look to you for guidance?
- Ask God to give you a mature view of your finances and to give you a generous spirit as you place your dependence and trust in Him.
