




REVELATION 2: 18-29

MAIN POINTS FROM LAST WEEK'S SERMON

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

Answer after reading Rev. 2:18

- What do we learn about Jesus from His eyes that are like a flame of fire? (Jeremiah 23:24; Hebrews 4:13)
 - How do these character qualities of Jesus influence your life?

Answer after reading Rev. 2:19

- What does Jesus compliment the church of Thyatira for?
- How do love and works relate to each other? (1 Timothy 4:15)

Answer after reading Rev. 2:20-21

- What did Jesus criticize the church for?
- Why might a church tolerate someone like this Jezebel?
- What specific temptations was she seducing the church with?
- How are those similar to temptations we face today?
- How can you protect yourself from such temptations?
 Your family? Your church?



Answer after reading Rev. 2:22-23

- What is Jesus going to do if there is no repentance?
- Who might "her children" refer to in verse 23?
- What does the judgment of Jesus teach us about His character?
- In light of this warning, what should you do?

Answer after reading Rev. 2:24-25

- What do we learn about the church from the phrase "to the rest of you in Thyatira?"
- What counsel does He offer the real believers in this church?
- Practically speaking, what can you do to "hold fast what you have?"

- What temptation do you need to conquer?
 - What does Jesus promise those who conquer?
- What is the Spirit saying to you in this passage? What do you need to obey?
