Discussion Questions

1. The Power Within You (Romans 8:11)

- What does it mean to you that the same power that raised Jesus now lives in you?
- Why do you think many believers still feel powerless even though this power is available?
- How would your daily life change if you truly believed God's power was active in you?

2. Power That Transforms (2 Corinthians 12:9)

- Paul says God's power is made perfect in weakness. Why is that difficult to accept?
- In what areas of your life do you feel weak right now?
- How can those areas become opportunities for God's power instead of limitations?

3. Power With Purpose (Acts 1:8)

- According to Acts 1:8, what is the primary purpose of the Holy Spirit's power?
- What fears or hesitations keep you from sharing your faith with others?
- Who is one person God may be prompting you to reach this week?

LIVING IT OUT

The Holy Spirit's power is not just something we believe in—it's something we experience daily. This week, focus on receiving, walking in, and relying on His power.

- **Step 1: Receive the Power** - Take time daily to pray: *“Holy Spirit, fill me again. Help me rely on Your power, not my own.”*
- **Step 2: Walk in Courage** - Identify one opportunity this week to:
 - Share your faith
 - Encourage someone
 - Step out in obedience
- **Step 3: Trust God in Weakness** - When you feel weak, remind yourself: *“God's power is working in me right now.”*
