READ Colossians 1:16

 How does this verse reinforce the idea that Jesus' resurrection was an act of divine authority, demonstrating power over life and death?

Don't Be Afraid (Matthew 28:5-7; 2 Timothy 1:7)

 Why do you think the angel's first message to the women was "Do not be afraid"? How can we apply this command to live in joy rather than fear in our own lives?

READ 2 Timothy 1:7

 How does knowing the power of the resurrection help us combat fear and live with confidence?

Conclusion: Embracing Resurrection Power

 How does the resurrection empower us to face struggles, fears, and pains with hope?

LIVING IT OUT

As you reflect on Jesus being driven by the resurrection, do the following with the leading of the Holy Spirit:

- *Daily Reminder*: Set a daily alarm with the message "Do not be afraid, for He has risen!" Use this as a moment to pause, reflect, and pray, inviting resurrection joy into your day.
- Hope Inventory: Identify one area where you've been seeking hope in "dead places." Commit to redirecting this hope towards Jesus through prayer and scripture reflection.
- Joyful Witness: Choose one way to share the joy of the resurrection this week, whether through a conversation, social media post, or an act of kindness.
