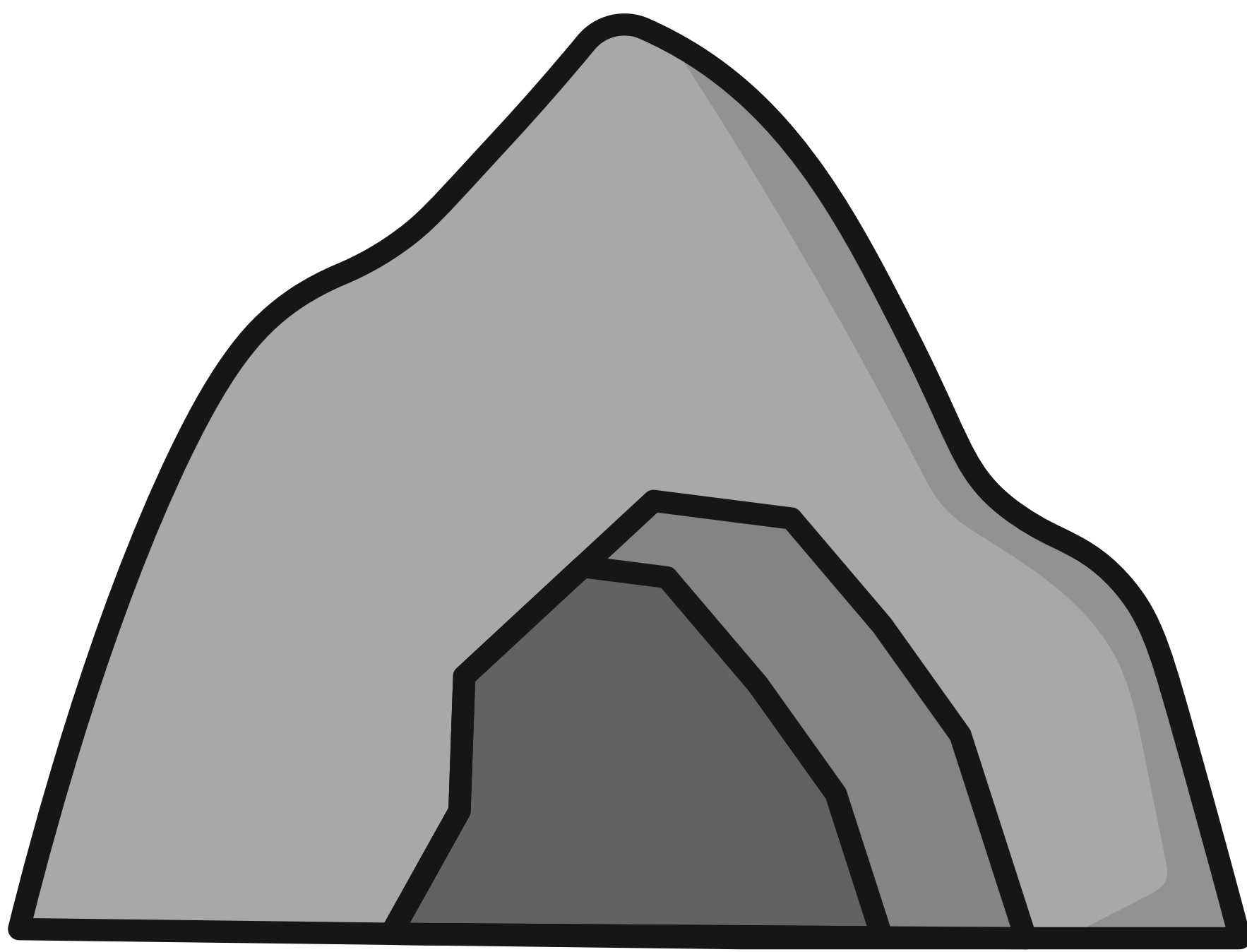



MAIN POINTS FROM THE SERMON

We can see from David's Wilderness experience that ...

- **IN THE WILDERNESS WE FIND INTEGRITY**
- **TRUST IN GOD'S JUSTICE AND TIMING**

- **SEEK GOD'S WILL**

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

READ 1 Samuel 24:1-6

- Discuss the definition of integrity: “The quality of being honest and having strong moral principles that you refuse to change.”
 - How was this evident in David’s actions?
- How can believers maintain their integrity, especially during their “wilderness” moments?
- How does David’s decision not to harm Saul illustrate mercy and non-retaliation?
 - Discuss instances where you find it challenging to respond with kindness and forgiveness. How can you overcome these challenges?
- Why is it important for believers to trust in God's plans and timing rather than trying to force our own agenda?
 - How can we remain steadfast and continue to do good, trusting that we will reap a harvest at the proper time?
- Why is it essential for believers to align their actions and decisions with God’s will, especially during challenging times?
 - Discuss ways in which you can seek and align yourself with God’s will during “wilderness” times.

LIVING IT OUT SECTION

Remember, sometimes we are chased into the Wilderness and we need to understand it's for our good.

the journey of trusting God more fully, especially when you are in the "wilderness moments" of life, is a gradual process. Each day this week, reflect on God's word and apply it to your life.

- **Reflection:**

- How can this week's lesson about integrity, God's authority, and seeking God's will guide your actions and decisions in the coming week?
- Find one practical step they can take this week to apply the lesson learned from David's experience in their lives

All week, pray for God's guidance to live with integrity, to trust in His timing, to forgive as we have been forgiven, and to seek His will above our own, especially during our "wilderness" experiences.
