Key Scriptures: Micah 5:2, Luke 2:1-14

Last week, we explored how God prepared the table for His Son's arrival, separating light from darkness. This past Sunday, we celebrated the King's arrival, born in humility to bring hope, love, and belonging to the world.



Discussion Questions

READ Micah 5:2

- What does this prophecy reveal about God's ways of accomplishing His plans?
- How does God's choice of Bethlehem encourage you in areas of your life where you feel small or insignificant?
- How does Bethlehem's significance in David's story connect to Jesus' birth and God's ongoing plan for redemption?

READ Luke 2:6-7

- How does Jesus' birth in a manger reflect the values of God's kingdom?
- In what ways can you cultivate humility and grace in your daily life, following the example of Jesus' birth?
- Why did God choose humble circumstances for Jesus' birth, and how does that influence your understanding of following Him?

READ Luke 2:10-11

- Why do you think God chose shepherds to be the first to hear about Jesus' birth?
- How does the invitation to “all people” encourage you to share hope with others this week?
- How does the angel's message of “great joy” challenge you to live out and share the good news of Jesus with those around you?

Living It Out

Jesus' humble birth reminds us that God values the unexpected and the overlooked. This week, let's live out His kingdom by embracing humility, sharing hope, and extending His love to everyone we meet. Practice these actions to live out the truths of the sermon:

1. **Cultivate humility**: Find one way to serve others in a simple, unnoticed way, reflecting Jesus' humble beginnings.
2. **Offer hope**: Share a word of encouragement or prayer with someone who might feel overlooked or insignificant.
3. **Invite others to the table**: Look for an opportunity to invite someone into your life—whether through a meal, conversation, or an act of kindness—to reflect Christ's invitation to all.
