DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

READ 1 Samuel 30:1-6

- Imagine walking in David and his men's shoes.
 - O How would you feel upon seeing your town burned and your loved ones taken captive?
- How did the men react to the crisis, and how did their reactions differ from David's?
 - What can this teach us about the importance of where (or in whom) we place our trust during difficult times?

READ Proverbs 19:21

- How do you typically respond when your expectations or plans don't align with God's purpose?
 - Can you share a time when God's purpose later became clear despite initial disappointments?

READ 1 Samuel 30:6

- Like David, have you experienced a situation where you were deeply distressed but chose to find strength in the Lord?
 - What actions did you take following that encouragement?

LIVING IT OUT SECTION

As we learned this week, in the face of overwhelming distress, David turned to the Lord for strength and guidance.

This week, when faced with challenges:

- Pause and seek God's presence before reacting impulsively.
- Let His peace calm your spirit, and
- allow the Holy Spirit to guide your decisions.
