- Open with prayer.
- If your groups is new, give everyone time to introduce themselves.

CONVERSATION STARTERS

- What's one thing you're looking forward to in the future?
- Share something new or a highlight from this past week.

REVIEW

Open your Bibles and read from John 17:1-6.

- Share your favourite points from the weekend sermon. What spoke to you?
- Share a phrase or moment that you related to the most, or a question you may have from the weekend.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- When do you normally turn to God in prayer?
- What is eternal life? How would you describe eternal life to someone?
- What did Jesus mean asking the Father to glorify Him (Jesus)?
- Why did He want the Father to glorify Him? How is Jesus' deity emphasized here?
- How would you describe Jesus' relationship with the Father? Why do you think Jesus was interested only in the Father's recognition?
- What can you do today to bring God glory?
- What does it look like for you to "be all in"?
- How does this verse apply to your life? What will you do about it?

PRAISE & PRAYER POINTS

Share what God is doing in your life and spend some time praying for each other's prayer requests.
