

Fall Sunday School Schedule

This year, all adult Sunday School classes will follow the same curriculum. We will be organizing the classes in a new way:

- Participants will choose their own “table groups”--4-6 people who will be together through the entire school year.
- We will divide all the table groups into classes led by a teacher, and those classes will meet together for the Fall term (September-November).
- Each term we will reshuffle the table groups into new classes. Our goal is that each table group will get to spend at least one term with every other table group.

Classes will begin next Sunday (Sep. 21st). Anyone who joins after that will be added to a class and then placed in a new Table Group at the beginning of the next term.
