Covenant is a legal bond of life and death, often called a bond in blood because life is in the blood. It is mentioned in Scripture directly through the words berith, chesed and syntheke as well as indirectly as the covenant treaty is the form that Scripture takes.



The original meaning of the Hebrew berith is not "agreement or settlement between two parties" as is commonly argued. Berith implies first and foremost the notion of "imposition," "liability," or "obligation," as might be learned from the "bond" etymology.

The question is not whether humanity is in a covenant relationship to God. It is "What is the nature of that covenantal relationship? Are they in Christ and therefore in the blessing of the covenant (life) or in Adam and therefore under the curse (death)?" Either way, they remain bound in covenantal obligation to God.



Knowing that is where history is headed, God brings hope by renewing the covenant in successive covenants. They are not a series of different covenant but one progressive revelation of what the eternal covenant in Christ entails.

5 ASPECTS OF SUZERAIN COVENANTS:

- **Preamble: Transcendence -** The Preamble declaring who the king is as well as his power
- **Historical Prologue: Hierarchy -** A rehearsing of the Kings actions and how the king's rule is worked out in representatives
- Ethics Establishment of law stipulations to be observed
- Sanctions Imposition of an oath which involving blessing or cursing
- **Continuity** Successional and depository arrangements. Calling of witnesses. Specifying the continuation of the covenant, successors and where the covenant would be stored.

- Hierarchy Immanence by His Spirit in anointing rulers
- Ethics Word

HIERARCHY: ESTABLISHMENT OF 4 SPHERES

- 1. Individual Image of God, Cultivating the earth (Vocation)
- 2. Family Marriage and Filling the earth (Raising of Children)
- 3. Rule and Subdue Enforcement of justice (State)
- 4. **Temple -** Prophet/Priest (idol) establishing the shalom or sabbath rest of God (Church)
