Now when they drew near to Jerusalem, to Bethphage and Bethany, at the Mount of Olives, Jesus sent two of his disciples and said to them, “Go into the village in front of you, and immediately as you enter it you will find a colt tied, on which no one has ever sat. Untie it and bring it. If anyone says to you, ‘Why are you doing this?’ say, ‘The Lord has need of it and will send it back here immediately.’” And they went away and found a colt tied at a door outside in the street, and they untied it. Messianic Secret:

1:25 But Jesus rebuked him, saying, "Be silent, and come out of him!"

1:34 And he healed many who were sick with various diseases, and cast out many demons. And he would not permit the demons to speak, because they knew him.

1:43-45 And Jesus sternly charged him and sent him away at once, and said to him, "See that you say nothing to anyone, but go, show yourself to the priest and offer for your cleansing what Moses commanded, for a proof to them." But he went out and began to talk freely about it, and to spread the news, so that Jesus could no longer openly enter a town, but was out in desolate places, and people were coming to him from every quarter.

Messianic Secret:

3:12 And he strictly ordered them not to make him known.

4:11 And he said to them, "To you has been given the secret of the kingdom of God, but for those outside everything is in parables"

5:43 And he strictly charged them that no one should know this, and told them to give her something to eat.

6:45 Immediately he made his disciples get into the boat and go before him to the other side, to Bethsaida, while he dismissed the crowd. And after he had taken leave of them, he went up on the mountain to pray.

Messianic Secret:

7:36 And Jesus charged them to tell no one. But the more he charged them, the more zealously they proclaimed it.

8:30 And he strictly charged them to tell no one about him.

9:9 And as they were coming down the mountain, he charged them to tell no one what they had seen, until the Son of Man had risen from the dead.
