6 KEY POINTS WE CAN DRAW FROM NATURAL BUILDINGS THAT APPLY TO THE SPIRITUAL HOUSE:

1. YOU CANNOT BUILD IN THE DARKTHERE MUST BE VISION

2. FOUNDATIONS ARE CRITICAL



So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone, in whom the whole structure, being joined together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord. In him you also are being built together into a dwelling place for God by the Spirit.

EPHESIANS 2:19-22



For we are God's fellow workers. You are God's field, God's building. According to the grace of God given to me, like a skilled master builder I laid a foundation, and someone else is building upon it. Let each one take care how he builds upon it. For no one can lay a foundation other than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ.

1 CORINTHIANS 3:9-11



Now if anyone builds on the foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straweach one's work will become manifest, for the Day will disclose it, because it will be revealed by fire, and the fire will test what sort of work each one has done. If the work that anyone has built on the foundation survives, he will receive a reward. If anyone's work is burned up, he will suffer loss, though he himself will be saved, but only as through fire.

3. BUILDING REQUIRES PLANNING AND COMMITMENT

4. BUILDING IS VERY HARD WORK
