

Holiness

To be separated away from things undermining [antithetical to] the Spirit of God's Word, sanctification (John 17: 14-16; Romans 12: 2)

Holiness is also...

1. Foundation of Salvation

You <u>CANNOT</u> say you're saved and <u>NOT</u> live in holiness

2.It is Our Call to Personal Holiness

Often we walk in wickedness to win over unbelievers, but it only ends in **HYPOCRISY**

3. Enables Fellowship with God

**Fellowship is IMPOSSIBLE without Holiness

1 John 2:4

How can we say we love God, but we are not obedient children to Him?

have a desire to please their parents

14 [Live] as obedient children [of God]; do not be

shaped, molded against God's will and Word conformed to the evil desires which governed

not knowing

you in your <u>ignorance</u> [before you knew the requirements and transforming power of the

good news regarding salvation]. 15 But like the

Holy One who called you, be holy yourselves in

all your conduct [be set apart from the world by

your godly character and moral courage]; 16

because it is written, "You shall be holy being in the world, not of it (set apart), for I am holy."

If you [really] love [God], you will keep and obey [His] commandments.

Whoever says, "I have come to know Him," but does not habitually keep [focused on His precepts and obey] His commandments (teachings), is a liar, and the truth [of the divine word] is not in him.

Renewing our MINDS

Romans 12: 2

What are you washing your mind with?

What good does it do to wash your mind (with the Word of God) only to jump back into the mud (worldly desires)?

And where your body will follow ...

That is why we **must** cast down every imagination that exalts itself above God

11 Corinthians 10: 5

As believers, we shouldn't get along with (to the point of tolerance)
those doing wrong

17 For the sinful nature has its desire which is opposed to the Spirit, and the [desire of the] Spirit opposes the [a]sinful nature; for these [two, the sinful nature and the Spirit] are in it is mutual direct opposition to each other [continually in Because we know better conflict], so that you [as believers] do not God will NOT be mocked Galatians 6:7 [always] do whatever you want to do] It is YOUR CHOICE... 18 But if you are guided and led by the Spirit, you are not subject to the Law. Law of Sin

and Death

19 Now the practices of the [b]sinful nature are clearly evident: they are sexual immorality, impurity, sensuality (total irresponsibility, lack witchcraft, manipulation of self-control), 20 [c]idolatry, [d]sorcery, hostility, personal, selfish want strife, jealousy, fits of anger, disputes, causing division and gossip dissensions, factions [that promote heresies], 21 believing you deserve what others have envy, drunkenness, riotous behavior, and other things like these. I warn you beforehand, just as I did previously, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.

Galatians 5: 19-21

gentleness, self-control. Against such things there is no law.


24 And those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the [1] sinful nature together with its passions and appetites.

25 If we [claim to] live by the [Holy] Spirit, we must also walk by the Spirit [with personal integrity, godly character, and moral courage—our conduct empowered by the Holy Spirit]. 26 We must not become conceited, challenging or provoking one another, envying one another.

Put your sins on open display

CRUCIFY your flesh



Let it be a public reminder of what you no longer do

Let your actions be a reflection of the CHOICE in your mind to walk by the HOLY SPIRIT

35 One of them, a lawyer [an expert in Mosaic Law], asked Jesus a question, to test Him: 36 "Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?" 37 And Jesus replied to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your <u>heart</u>, and with <u>all your soul</u>, and with <u>all</u> your mind.' 38 This is the first and greatest commandment.
