1. I submit to its authority.

Three ways a person may view the Bible:

- "The Bible under me".
- "The Bible beside me".
- "The Bible over me".

2. I seek out its wisdom.

"So that the [person] man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work." (vs. 17)

3. I stand on its unshakeable truths.

- •Do you believe that the Bible reveals the message of salvation through Jesus Christ? ("We do.")
- •Do you believe that the Bible is able to thoroughly equip you in every way to live a life pleasing to God? (The congregation answers: ("We do.")
