## **Unity Busters and Spirit Grievers**

**Ephesians 4:25-32** 

February 21, 2021

<sup>25</sup> Therefore each of you must put off <u>falsehood</u> and speak truthfully to his neighbor, for we are all members of one body. <sup>26</sup> "In your <u>anger</u> do not sin": Do not let the sun go down while you are still angry, <sup>27</sup> and do not give the devil a foothold. <sup>28</sup> He who has been <u>stealing</u> must steal no longer, but must work, doing something useful with his own hands, that he may have something to share with those in need.

<sup>29</sup> Do not let any <u>unwholesome talk</u> come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen. <sup>30</sup> And do not <u>grieve the Holy Spirit of God</u>, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. <sup>31</sup> Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice. <sup>32</sup> Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.

The Holy Spirit is grieved by our *reckless words*. (vs. 29)

Proverbs 12:18, "Reckless words pierce like a sword, but the tongue of the wise brings healing."

Eph. 4:29: Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen.

What are some example of rotten or trashy words?

Indecent, vulgar language.

Dirty jokes, off-color stories.

Obscenity.

Racial or ethnic insults.

Humor meant to harm or insult.

Angry outbursts; harsh words.

Comments that are mean-spirited.

Gossip, rumors, false accusations.

Threats and intimidating comments.

Hurtful criticism.

Cheap shots.

Talking too much.

Talking without listening.

Condemning others.

Exaggerating the faults of others.

Empty excuses for justifying unkind words by saying, "I was only joking" or "I didn't really mean it".

The Holy Spirit is grieved by our rotten attitudes. (vs. 31)

"Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice" (v. 31).
